

Inclement Weather Policy

By virtue of living in Colorado, we are presented with extreme weather conditions from time to time. For the safety of our patients and our staff, we may be forced to close our office(s) when it has been determined that road conditions are not safe for travel. Please review our Inclement Weather Policy:

- **Memorial Hospital:** For patients scheduled for treatment under general anesthesia at Memorial Hospital's Printers Park Medical Plaza and Surgery Center, located at 175 South Union Blvd., Suite 100, Colorado Springs, CO 80910, your appointment will remain "as scheduled". If road conditions prevent safe travel, please notify Amanda Geldiashvili at or.visit@outlook.com or call 719-375-8316 as soon as possible. Failure to call, may impact your ability to reschedule your child's OR visit.
- **Briargate Office:** Our Briargate office, located at 9480 Briar Village Point, Suite 301, Colorado Springs, CO 90920 will be closed if the U.S. Airforce Academy is closed to non-essential personnel. Please visit www.usafa.af.mil or call 719-333-6249 for the most current information on inclement weather and reporting status.
- **Southgate Office:** Our Southgate office, located at 660 Southpointe Court, Suite 100, Colorado Springs, CO 80906 will be closed if Fort Carson Army Base is closed to non-essential personnel. Please visit www.carson.army.mil or call the Fort Carson Weather Hotline at 719-526-0096 for the most current information on inclement weather and reporting status.
- **Canon City Office:** Our Canon City office, located at 410 Macon Ave., Canon City, CO 81212 in the office of Kimra Hall and Associates will be closed if it is determined that our staff cannot safely travel from Colorado Springs to Canon City due to road conditions. Please call 719-276-0128 for more information.

We realize that snowy weather and icy roads can be daunting and it may be your preference to remain home with your child(ren). If you prefer not to travel, we will be happy to reschedule your child(ren)'s appointment(s), however, we do require a courtesy call. Please do not assume that our office is closed and that we are not anticipating your arrival. Failure to call, will be considered a No Show and may impact your ability to reschedule your child(ren)'s appointment(s).

In the event of closures, permitting we have a valid phone number, you will receive notification that our office(s) is closed due to weather conditions. If we are unable to reach you and assist you with rescheduling your child(ren)'s appointment, we will call again when our office reopens for business.
